

Sharpsville Borough Council met in Regular Session on Wednesday, May 13, 2026 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers at 1 S. Walnut Street, Sharpsville, PA.

Councilman Combine offered a brief prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance was said by all.

Roll Call: Roll call showed the following present: Casey Anglin, Chris Combine, Kim Fryman, Nick Hanahan, Bob Piccirilli and Len Grandy

Also present were: Borough Manager/Secretary Ken Robertson

Absent were: Tom Patton, Solicitor, John Alfredo and Mayor, Mark Gill

Approval of Minutes: A motion was made by Councilman Piccirilli and seconded by Councilman Fryman to approve the minutes of the Regular Session Meeting Minutes on April 8, 2026, and the Special Meeting on April 30, 2026. Motion Passed.

Comments from the Audience:

Heidi Marshall: She came before Council to discuss the Inclusive Playground project for which she is seeking funding. The proposed playground would be located behind Sharpsville Elementary School. She previously addressed Council last month regarding the efforts she has undertaken to secure funding; however, she has since encountered several obstacles and is requesting assistance from the Borough.

Initially, South Pymatuning Township was expected to serve as the co-applicant for the project, but after speaking with the grant analyst, Ms. Marshall was informed that the Township is not eligible. As a result, she is now seeking a new co-applicant. In order to meet the application deadline, she must obtain both a Letter of Intent and a Resolution from the new applicant by May 14, 2026, at 8:30 a.m.

Ms. Marshall also explained that another option would be to apply as a standalone 501(c)(3) organization; however, the approval process would likely delay the project until next year, which she is hoping to avoid.

Resolution 2137-Applying for Funding from the State Greenways, Trails and Recreation Program for the Development of an Inclusive Playground: A motion was made by Councilman Piccirilli and seconded by Councilman Combine to read the resolution. The resolution was read by the Secretary. A motion was made by Councilman Piccirilli and seconded by Councilman Combine to adopt Resolution 2137. Motion Passed.

Enter into a Playground Agreement with Sharpsville Area School District: A motion was made by Councilman Combine and seconded by Councilman Fryman to enter into an agreement with the Sharpsville Area School District regarding a playground. Motion Passed.

Engineering Agreement Amendment #1 for the Water System Improvements- A motion was made by Councilman Combine and seconded by Councilman Fryman to approve Amendment #1 for the Water System Improvement in the amount of \$203,000.00. Motion Passed.

Certificate of Substantial Completion Form for the N. Mercer Avenue Sidewalk Improvement Project: A motion was made by Councilman Piccirilli and seconded by Councilman Hanahan to approve the Certificate of Substantial Completion Form. Motion Passed.

Daniel A. Terreri and Sons Inc. Payment Application #2 for N. Mercer Avenue Sidewalk Improvement Project: A motion was made by Councilman Combine and seconded by Councilman Fryman to authorize payment in the amount of \$102,101.27 for the N. Mercer Avenue Sidewalk Project. \$1,055.45 will be paid with Borough Funds and the \$101,045.82 will be paid using CDBG Funds. Motion Passed.

EADS Zoning Ordinance Audit: A motion was made by Councilman Combine and seconded by Councilman Piccirilli to authorize a Zoning Ordinance Audit in the amount of \$6,000.00. Motion Passed.

“No Trucks” Sign Posted in the Alley between 5th Street and 6th Street: A motion was made by Councilman Combine and seconded by Councilman Fryman to authorize the “No Trucks” Sign posted in the alley between 5th Street & 6th Street. Motion Passed. A traffic study was completed by Chief Joseph and he recommended to prohibit commercial vehicle traffic mainly box trucks and tractor trailers.

EADS Agreement to Engineer Water Tank Rehabilitation and Water Line Replacement of Approximately 13,000 feet of waterline. A motion was made by Councilman Combine and seconded by Councilman Hanahan to approve the agreement with EADS. Motion Passed.

Authorization to Purchase a 20' Utility Trailer from Gerasimek: A motion was made by Councilman Combine and seconded by Councilman Fryman to authorize the purchase of the 20' Utility Trailer in the amount of \$4,995.00. Motion Passed.

Chris Combine: He commented that the flags placed on the sign in front of the Borough Building looked very nice. He then mentioned that the home on 7th Street, which had been recently cut by the Public Works Department, also looked very nice. Ken advised Council that the Public Works Department had completed both jobs and that they do great work.
